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RULES FOR THE PREMIER'S READING CHALLENGE

You must complete your online Student Reading Record by 28 August 2020



YEARS K-2



K-2 will complete the challenge as a class with their teacher. If you would like your child to complete the challenge at home they must read 30 books to complete the challenge. You must read a minimum number of 25 K-2 PRC books and a maximum number of 5 personal choice books.

YEARS 3-4



3-4 students must read 20 books to complete the challenge. You must read a minimum number of 15 3-4 or 5-6 PRC books and a maximum number of 5 personal choice books.

YEARS 5-6



5-6 students must read 20 books to complete the challenge. You must read a minimum number of 15 5-6 PRC books and a maximum number of 5 personal choice books.
